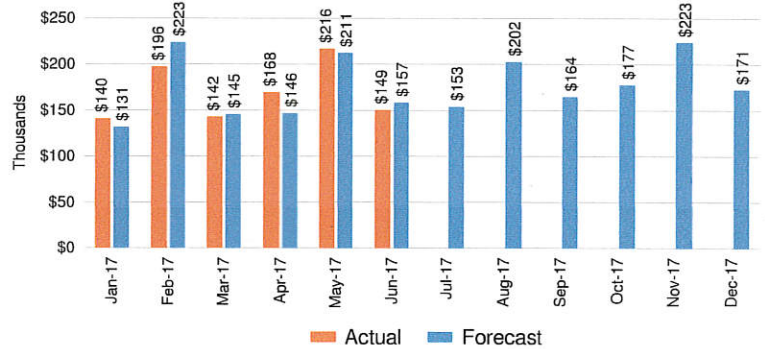

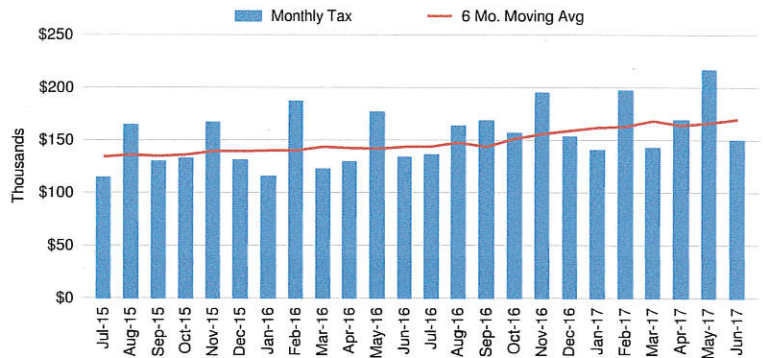

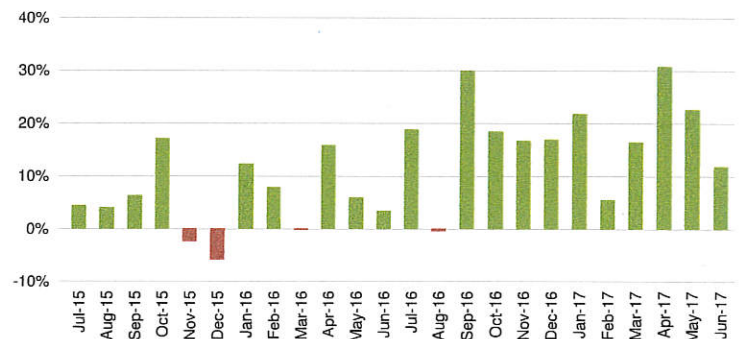
Sales Tax Net Payments: FY Actual/Forecast



Sales Tax Net Payments Trend



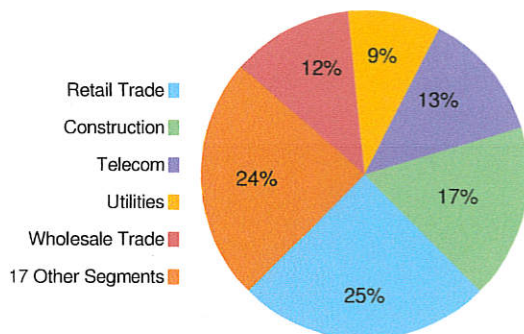
Sales Tax Net Payments Change - YoY

ITEM #4 – HEARING OF VISITORS

PROCEDURES FOR CITIZEN PARTICIPATION AT MEETINGS

1. Citizens are encouraged to discuss matters of concern with the staff and individual council members prior to placing items on the agenda. This will allow the matter to be properly investigated before it is presented to the entire council and will often expedite a resolution.

NO CITIZEN OR STAFF MEMBER MAY SPEAK OR OTHERWISE INTERRUPT ANY MEETING UNTIL RECOGNIZED BY THE PRESIDING OFFICER.

2. To maintain decorum at public hearings, the mayor will ask citizens in attendance if they wish to speak for or against the item on the agenda. If so, they will be given an opportunity to speak at the proper time and when recognized by the chair. If more than five citizens wish to address the council on any single agenda item, those citizens are advised to select a spokesperson to present their case.

Only under the agenda item “Hear Visitors” are citizens permitted to speak regarding matters that pertain to city business or address an item on the agenda. **The council is prohibited by law from discussing or acting on any item that has not been posted on the agenda.**

3. Individual citizens that discuss items not listed on the agenda shall be limited to **five minutes**. If five or more citizens wish to discuss a single item or topic that is not listed on the agenda, then the total presentation will be limited to a maximum of twenty-five minutes. City council members shall **not** enter into discussion on any subject that has not been properly placed on the agenda; however, council members may ask questions for clarification purposes.
4. As a general rule, citizens may not participate or address the council or staff during the workshop session.

ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Authorize purchase of Dell server and two (2) hard drives.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION/ITEM SUMMARY:

There are five (5) servers currently in use by the city that are each four (4) to six (6) years old. These servers store and fetch data related to day to day operations and are integral to city operations. This includes STW (the City's Utility Billing Software) as well as the Municipal Court system, and other departmental data storage. These older servers are physically located in City Hall and were moved from the old City Hall building.

Recent issues with these servers caused city staff to request analysis from our Information Technology consultant (Extraco) concerning replacement and upgrade of city servers. Extraco provided the City with the attached quote which would replace all of the servers currently in use with one (1) new server. The proposal includes additional storage and, of course, faster processors. Moreover, the proposal includes improved data redundancy (ie. backup) which would allow a faster recovery in case of a system crash or other unforeseen incident.

Staff recommends using excess BB&T lease funds to purchase the specified Dell server and two (2) hard drives.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION/ITEM SUMMARY:

Hewitt's Water Utilities Department is initiating "in house" replacement and repair of water lines along Hewitt Drive and Sun Valley Boulevard. Approximately 1,100 linear feet of 12" water line will be installed along Hewitt Drive from Castleman Creek Elementary to Kiowa. Additionally, approximately 2,400 linear feet of 12" line will be installed along Sun Valley Boulevard from Bagby (Old Temple Road) to a point near H&M Landscaping.
