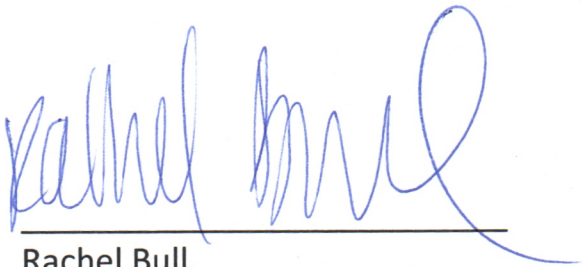
NOTICE OF MEETING OF THE PARKS AND BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE OF THE CITY OF HEWITT, TEXAS

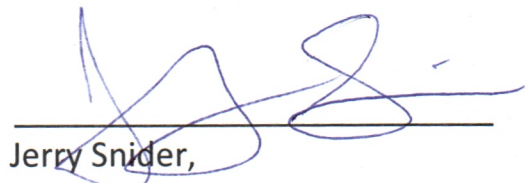
1. Call Parks and Beautification Committee to order.
 - a. 6:00 PM by Jerry Snider
2. Consider approval of minutes for the September 18th, 2019 meeting of the Parks and Beautification Committee regular meeting.
 - a. Motioned by Tom Hernandez, seconded by Casey Lowrey
3. Welcome new members
 - a. Welcomed two new committee members; Conway Briscoe and Jamie McKinney. The Parks and Beautification Committee is now at a full seven members. Tom Hernandez informed new members of ongoing goals and projects of the Parks and Beautification Committee.
4. Briefing and discussion on projects
 - a. Dog park
 - i. Discussion on Dog Days Pledges and Public response
 1. Reported that 23 pledges totaling around \$2,000 were filled out on Dog Days in support of the Glaze Dog Park. Around 50 more pledge forms were taken home by attendees to fill out at a later time.
 - ii. Discussion of City Council Workshop Date
 1. Discussion on potential questions the Parks and Beautification Committee needs to be prepared to answer at a future workshop with City Council. Items to consider include potential revenue, tax rates, and the City of Hewitt's liability for the Dog Park's visitors.
 - iii. Discussion of website to monitor Dog Park Pledge progress

 - a. Discussion of having a presentation of the Glaze Dog Park completed in four stages to adjust in order to present to City Council, and what other information the Parks and Beautification Committee needs to present to City Council.
